## **EUTRO 2010 Symposium**

The Third International Symposium on Research and Management of Eutrophication in Coastal Ecosystems (EUTRO 2010) will take place 15 – 18 June 2010 in Nyborg, Denmark. The specific objectives of EUTRO 2010 are: (1) to present and discuss the current conceptual understanding of coastal eutrophication, (2) to present and discuss new knowledge in regard to coastal eutrophication, (3) to discuss how existing nutrient management strategies are performing, (4) to discuss if and how existing monitoring, assessment and nutrient management strategies could be improved, and (5) to discuss new and emerging issues. Further, EUTRO 2010 aims to support better communication and understanding between scientists and managers. The workshop will be held in Messukeskus, Helsinki on April 12th, 2010.

The aim of the workshop is to initiate discussion on the RTD topics to be eventually addressed in the joint calls in the future. It is anticipated that such calls, and the multinational projects emerging from them, will be co-funded by the basic research financiers grouped under the BONUS EEIG, the European Commission and the agencies supporting technological innovation. The workshop is open for all interested representatives of technology research funding organisations, companies, scientists, results' endusers.
